How to support your child in

English this term

Continue to share a story with your child at home including their school library book. Talk to your child about the story , encouraging your child to say what they did or did not enjoy about the story. Which character did they like? Why? Can they predict what might happen next?

If your child has a school reading book or library book comment in the yellow home school reading diary to let us know how your child is getting on.

Keep checking the Phonics display in the Nursery entrance for new sounds being taught.

Things to Practise in Maths this term

Continue to help your child count up to 20. We would love for as many children as possible in Nursery to achieve at least their Bronze badge by the end of this half term!

If your child already has their bronze you could work towards earning their silver badge. Encourage your child to count items within their home environment (10 apples or 5 stairs) We have had lot of success with children achieving their silver badge, well done! Working towards a gold badge can be tricky... encourage your child to count out items from a basket. Start low e.g. 5 and then work your way up!

Challenge your child to identify numerals in the environment. Can they recognise 1-10?

Other ways to help your child

We are really impressed with the number of children who can nearly write their names so keep practicing!

Continue to encourage your child to put on their coat and shoes independently.

If you observe your child doing something special outside of Nursery please make a note of it on a WOW moment slip . These can be found in your child's homework book (Yellow Class only) or in the Nursery entrance. The children love seeing them in their learning journeys!
