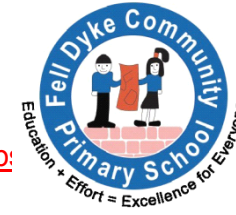

How to support your child in English this term

Read a range of fictional texts and ask your child to retell the story. Ask your child what happened at the beginning, middle and end of the story.

Find out facts about Artic animals.

Look at non-fiction books and discuss how they are different to fiction (story) books.

Write sentences about Artic animals using capital letters, spaces and full stops.

Practise writing your first and surname.

Things to Practise in Maths this term

Practise writing numerals to 20.

Counting forwards and backwards to 30.

Add groups of 2 objects together e.g. Fred has 2 cakes and Bob has 3 cakes, how many altogether?

Takeaway amounts using objects e.g. pennies, buttons etc.

Find numbers that total different amounts within 10 e.g. $3+5=8$ or $4+4=8$

Other ways to help your child

Help improve their fine motor skills:

- Play tidily winks
- Complete tracing activities
- Thread laces
- Roll dough
- Fasten buttons
