### How to support your child in English this term

Share pirate adventure stories or find out facts about real-life pirates.

Write in role as a pirate. You could try a diary entry or speech bubbles.

Use your senses to write a pirate poem. What can you see , hear and feel on a pirate ship.

Check all your writing for capital letters, punctuation, finger spaces and read for sense.

Ask your children to spell words using letter names.

### Things to Practise in Maths this term

Ask your children to complete subtraction sums. E.g.  $20-5=?$  Can they use equipment or a numberline to help them? Can they write the addition sum to match e.g.  $15+5=20$ .

Ask your children to cut food into halves and then quarters. Can they find half of an amount and quarter of an amount.

Look at different ways to tell the time. Try to read o'clock and half past on the analogue clock.

Try to use positional language to describe a route. Maybe you could direct a blind-folded friend using forwards, backwards, left and right.

### Other ways to help your child

Use the internet to research sea creatures or pirates.

Practise new spellings several times a week.

Ask your child to check their homework sentences to make sure they have used capital letters and full stops.

Continue to work on the creative homework— remember it can be done over a half term.
